PAST OUTREACH & FUNDRAISING EVENTS

During the past year the Marine Corps League South Coast Detachment has undertaken many outreach and fundraising events. Below are a few examples of things that we were able to accomplish. The events held are as follows:

• CONCERTS IN THE PARK (FUNDRAISING): JULY& AUG 2023 The Marine Corps League hosted six Sundays by supporting Dana Point Concerts in the Park with the organization of our Spirits Garden. During these concerts the city had approximately 2,000-10,000 who enjoyed the live music. In order to facilitate the patrons with the Spirits Garden we were able to get some much-needed help from many active-duty Marines from Camp Pendleton with their families to assist alongside our regular membership. After the completion of these events, we were able to fundraise \$31,455.



IWO JIMA GOLF TOURNAMENT (FUNDRAISING): AUG 2023

Last year we hosted our inaugural golf tournament at Bella Collina Golf Course where we were able to sponsor 46 Marines/Veterans for a total of 144 golfers. We were able to generate \$20,254 in fundraising. We were able to give a total of \$10,000.00 to two double amputee Marine Veterans to help support them and their families.

• VETERANS EXPO (OUTREACH): OCT 2023

The Detachment was able to have an inaugural Veterans Expo at the beautiful Casa Romantica in San Clemente. We hosted 15 vendors from Colleges, Businesses and various non-profit Organizations to support the local veteran community. We provided a light lunch and refreshments at no cost. We had the 5th District Supervisor Katrina Foley & Mayor of San Clemente Chris Duncan assist the Detachment handing out Scholarships to deserving Veterans and their families in the total amount of **\$17,500**. This event was in collaboration with the *Dana Point VFW Post 9934 and*

the San Clemente American Legion Post 423. We also had support from the JROTC program from San Clemente High School. Lastly, we were able to donate \$10k to Casa Romantica to ensure we can to continue hosting this Veteran Expo into the future yearly at no further cost.

Marine Corps Birthday was hosted at the beautiful Laguna Cliffs Marriott in Dana Point where we were able to get 70 active-duty Marines and their dates sponsored to attend. We had 289 in total

attendance. We had the 74th District Assemblywoman Laurie Davies, the 5th district Supervisor Katrina Foley, Mayors from both cities of Dana Point and San Clemente, and many other dignitaries from the community to witness and celebrate our heritage.



• 2/1 CHRISTMAS TOY DRIVE (OUTREACH): DEC 2023

The Detachment was able to conduct toys for tots' drive within the community with various locations of boxes for toys. After our campaign we were able to provide over 3,000 toys to active-duty families for the holidays.



• 2/1 CHRISTMAS DINNERS (OUTREACH): DEC 2023

We were able to provide 50 hams along with the rest of the meal for a wonderful Christmas dinner. We were able to facilitate this campaign in conjunction with *Nobel Vikings out of Newport Beach.*

• 2023 EMERGENCY GRANT \$ 400,000

The Detachment also wrote and was awarded an emergency grant in the amount of \$400,000 for Veterans and their families in Orange County District, which was extended to over 100 families through scholarships, needed home improvements, medical assistance, community outreach donations to various non-profit organizations.

Furthermore, the 5th District County Supervisor, Katrina Foley awarded two members of the Detachement, **Tony Faulkner as Veteran of the year in Laguna Niguel** and **Nelson Coburn as Veteran of the year in San Clemente.**

• VETERAN'S COMEDY NIGHT (OUTREACH/ FUNDRAISING): JAN 2024

The Detachment helped sponsor a "Comedy Night at the San Clemente Casino" featuring the talents of active and retired service members and family members and in partnership with a local non-profit, My Creative PTSD. The event raised \$5,000 for veterans with PTSD.



• FESTIVAL OF WHALES (FUNDRAISING): MAR 2024 We conducted a fundraiser during the Dana Point Festival of Whales, raising \$25,000 for continued use in veteran and community outreach.


